### **BIO**

M83 was formed as a musical vehicle by Anthony Gonzalez in 2001. Over the course of 10 years, Gonzalez released six albums under the M83 name, including the Grammy-nominated album “Hurry Up, We’re Dreaming” (2011). The supporting world tour for “Hurry Up, We’re Dreaming” lasted more than a year as Gonzalez enhanced the growing reputation for the variety and excellence of M83’s live performances. Though having worked in his native France for the majority of his career, Gonzalez relocated to Los Angeles in 2009, in part to aid his desire to undertake score work for film and television. Various introductions were quickly made, and it was less than a year later that Gonzalez was approached by Joseph Kosinski with the offer of a commission for his forthcoming film, Oblivion.
